KEY WARNINGS

- Risk of cognitive offloading students losing critical thinking skills
- Danger of reducing education to algorithmic efficiency
- Academic integrity challenges require urgent attention

PRIORITY ACTIONS FOR OUR INSTITUTION

For Faculty:

- Invest in AI literacy training for all educators
- Protect teacher autonomy while embracing Al tools
- Focus on evidence-informed practices

For Students:

- Implement UNESCO AI Competency Framework (2024)
- Strengthen critical thinking and higher-order skills
- Prevent overreliance on Al systems

For Institution:

- Develop comprehensive AI strategy
- Balance top-down guidance with bottom-up innovation
- Create governance mechanisms for impact evaluation


